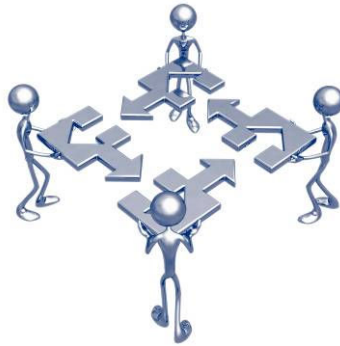

Ethnicity Changes and IQ Web Self-Service. The federal government recently changed the way it collects demographic data to better accommodate people with a multi-ethnic heritage. You can use your IQ Web Self-Service account to adjust the way JCHS reports your ethnicity.

- Anyone with a Self-Service account can change their demographic information
- In Self-Service, located under My Profile -> Ethnicity and Race
- There is no confirmation in Self-Service that the information is saved. Once the user hits the button it saves, but it doesn't provide a message to the user saying so.
