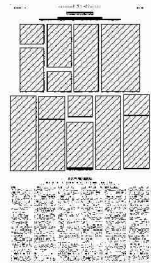
Paul Sorrentino has been named the Clifford A. Cutchins professor of English by the Virginia Tech Board of Visitors.
