

Virginia providers win health care training grants

Virginia health care training programs have received more than \$5.5 million in grants from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

Southwest and Central Virginia awards include \$18,992 for nursing education at Carilion Clinic and Jefferson College of Health Sciences; \$150,600 for nursing education and \$124,368 for geriatric education at Radford University; \$306,394 for nursing education at Southwest Virginia Community College; and \$1,221,175 for nursing education at Virginia Highlands Community College.

The grants support nursing work force development programs and provide training that focuses on the health needs of the aging population.
