ROANOKE — Jefferson College of Health Science (JCHS) has been granted approval to offer Master of Science degrees in Occupational Therapy and Physician Assistant by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

Both programs will begin

classes in the fall of this year and are currently accepting applications from students.

JCHS was given approval to begin offering graduate level courses in 2005 moving the college from Carnegie Level II designation to Carnegie Level III.

JCHS implemented the Master of Science in Nursing program in 2005 and graduated the first class in May of 2007.

JCHS is a private higher education institution that focuses on providing healthcare education and is fully integrated with Carillon Clinic.
